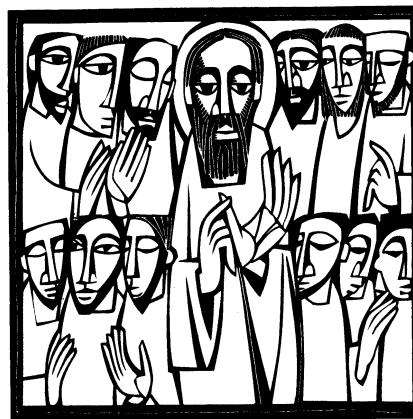
A Family Perspective
