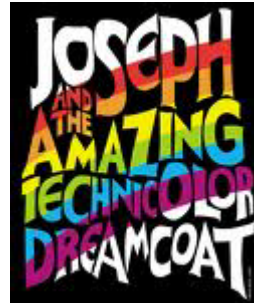
### Clothing Drive at Our Parish
